Immediate Mental Health Assessments are available to all Crisis Placements if required (min 6 weeks duration).

Care Afloat Mobile: (Ofsted registered) our unique new facility combining our twenty years' experience of water-based placements with land-based outdoor activities anywhere in the UK. Young people can spend from weeks to months tasting adventure, facing challenges and travelling. Training courses and educational achievement are an integral part of the provision.

Narrowboat Waterworks: our floating registered children's home.

Prilika: (Croatian for Opportunity) our eight berth modern yacht. Equipped for up to two young people, she is mainly used for individual referrals. Care Afloat has been providing sailing opportunities since 1991. Prilika is fully licensed as a small commercial vessel. She is only available from March to November inclusive.

Charmaine: a 70 foot narrow boat fully equipped for wheelchair access and is available for small groups or individuals.

Sharon: our oldest boat and at 38 feet is a cosy environment and a real chill out space.

Pride: our new 57' broad beam boat arrived in 2009 and is also fully wheelchair accessible.

Le Care Afloat: our three-roomed chalet in the south of France a chance for a holiday in the sun for a young person who just needs a break.

Access to Education/Training and national qualifications is an integral part of life on board our boats and our Mobile facilities.
